

SFM002 Emergency Procedures



1 Knock out

1.1 Fighter is not to be touched if lying on the floor, ref will encourage the fighter to stay put. The ringside medic will be able to enter the ring immediately. If emergency services are required the medic will ask the Timekeeper or MC to call them and give directions, the Timekeeper or Promoter will also meet the emergency services on arrival and take them to the patient.

1.2 A Timekeeper is to go get a second medic straight away to assist

1.3 The ref will prevent anyone entering the ring other than the fighters coach (ONLY)

1.4 Medics will carry out all medical examinations and be satisfied that the fighter is stable enough to be moved, stood up etc.

1.5 The fighter will be observed backstage near the post fight medic area and checked regularly. If the fighter needs further medical attention it will be the medic to call emergency services (If this is required post fight). In no circumstances will the fighter be left without a support person.

2 Ref Stoppage - Injury, due to having 3 8 counts in a fight, medical emergency

2.1 After a fight has been stopped, the ringside medic will enter the ring to check over the fighter to check for major signs.

2.2 If assistance is required proceed from section 1.2. If emergency services are required the medic will ask the Timekeeper or MC to call them and give directions, the Timekeeper or Promoter will also meet the emergency services on arrival and take them to the patient.

OR

If the ringside medic is satisfied the normal post medical procedure will proceed as normal.

3 Death (In the fight, audience/member of public ASAP)

3.1 Medics to be the only ones in the ring to perform any medical procedures they need to do to prolong life. The MC will be instructed by the medic to call emergency service immediately.

3.2 Any official filming should be stopped.

3.3 The show is to be stopped completely and the crowd addressed by the MC on how to exit safely. (The MC should also beware of the emergency procedures and address these at the start of the show.. Family should be allowed to remain of course).

3.4 If an audience member or anyone not directly fighting. The fight shall be stopped ASAP, access given immediately to medics, and the MC to calm the crowd to allow this to happen. A Timekeeper will also call the emergency services once directed by the medics. The Timekeeper will meet and direct the emergency services
